The College courses, offered to both Australian residents and overseas students, are designed to prepare students for entry to university.

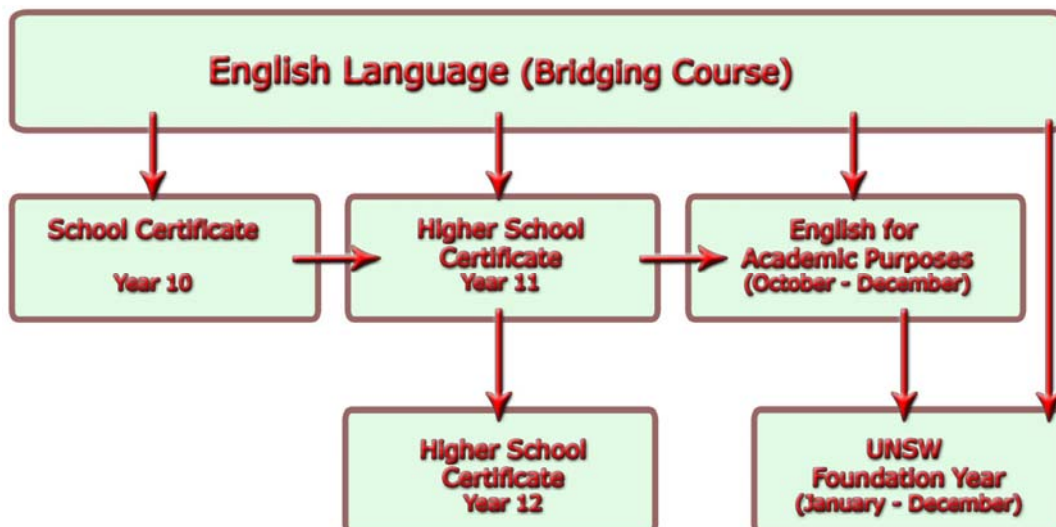
St. Paul's has an outstanding record of academic achievement, with an estimated 95% of its students progressing to Australian universities each year.

The English Language (Bridging) Course is a language-based course aimed at preparing students both linguistically and academically for their approved courses.

The EAP course prepares students for the academic language demands of the UNSW Foundation Year course.

Courses for Years 10, 11 and 12 at St. Paul's are accredited by the New South Wales Board of Studies, which is a state government body.

Students who enrol for the Higher School Certificate course enter the Preliminary Year (Year 11) and, on completion of all course requirements, progress to Year 12.
