	3	Students use the elements of drama and improvisational activities to learn how to create dynamic and
	4	original collaborative performances pieces. In this unit students are introduced to making, performing,
	5	and appreciating dramatic work.

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2	1	Unit: Commedia dell' arte (25 hours)
	2	Focus Outcomes: 5.1.1, 5.1.2, 5.1.4, 5.2.2, 5.2.3, 5.3.2, 5.3.3.
	3	In this unit students study the context and conventions of Commedia dell'arte. This unit incorporates
	4	the use of mask, comedy and improvisation to explore character and scenarios. Students will create
	5	their own character mask, and perform a contemporary devised work using their mask.
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	7	Major Assessment- Mask Performance (Group or Solo)
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3	1	Unit: Scripted Drama (25 hours)
	2	Focus Outcomes: 5.1.3, 5.1.4, 5.2.1., 5.2.3, 5.2.2, 5.3.1, 5.3.2, 5.3.3
	3	Unit- Scripted Drama- students learn how to interpret and perform scripted drama, using production
	4	elements to enhance their final performance. Students will also review a play.
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	6	Major Assessments- Performance of a scripted scene and Theatre Review
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4	1	Unit: Creative Movement (20 hours)
	2	Focus Outcomes: 5.1.1, 5.1.2, 5.1.4, 5.2.1, 5.2.2, 5.2.3.,5.3.1
	3	Students explore movement and physical theatre through the work of various theatre companies.
	4	Students will create an original piece of drama demonstrating their knowledge and skills modelled off a
	5	chosen form or practitioner studied in the unit.
