

Year 8 English - Assessment Plan - 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills in-class reading and comprehension of content from a wide variety of sources, analysis of sources.
- Writing skills: summaries, sentences and paragraphs, note-taking, identifying and composing various text types. Eg: opinion piece, short story, poetry, interview, news story, essay
- Speaking skills: oral presentation, debating

Tasks used for assessment include (but are not limited to):

Term 1

 Creating a storyboard for the Ancient Mariner (EN4-1A, EN4-2A, EN4-6C, EN4-8D)

Term 2

 Presenting a speech (EN4-1A, EN4-3B, EN4-4B, EN4-5C, EN4-9E)

Term 3

 Creating a blog (EN4-2A, EN4-5C, EN4-7D, EN4-8D)

Term 4

 Writing an essay (EN4-1A, EN4-3B, EN4-4B, EN4-7D)
