

Stage 4 Technology Mandatory – Assessment Plan – 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement.
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Analysing Design Situations
- Research skills and using research in the decision making process.
- Skills in Recording and effectively communicating design ideas.
- Skills in developing solutions using a variety of materials.
- ICT skills in using a range of software including MS WORD, MS EXCEL, MS PowerPoint and scratch.
- Citing sources and incorporating bibliographies

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks:

- Term 1: Indigenous tools and weapons task, and toy design folio up to selection stage. (TE4-1DP, TE4-2DP, TE4-3DP, TE4-9MA, TE4-10TS)
- Term 2: Child's Toy and Design Folio (TE4-1DP, TE4-2DP, TE4-3DP, TE4-9MA, TE4-10TS)
- Term 3: Computer game Comparison report, and presentation of a Computer Game profession (TE4-1DP, TE4-2DP, TE4-3DP, TE4-9MA, TE4-10TS)
- Term 4: Completed Scratch game and Folio (TE4-1DP, TE4-2DP, TE4-3DP, TE4-9MA, TE4-10TS)
