



Year 7&8 Religious Education – Assessment Plan – 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Workbook completion
- Homework task completion
- Class participation – discussions, Q&A, listening, responding
- Group work involvement
- Research tasks
- Presenting to the class

Students will also complete the following formal assessment tasks:

- Term 1:
Map Task - construct a map and mark all the locations from the gospels
- Term 2:
Emmaus in a digital world
Caritas pamphlet task
- Term 3:
Research Activity on the four Catholic churches
Group poster activity on the actions and signs during the liturgy
- Term 4: Film trailer (group) and film pitch (individual)
Group Activity - statements of faith booklet based on John's Gospel
Oral Presentation - on someone who makes a difference by 'living the Christian life'
