



Year 7 Chinese – Assessment Plan – 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation – discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills - in-class reading and comprehension of content from a wide variety of sources
- Writing skills: note-taking, identifying, and composing various text types e.g., script, letter, email.
- Speaking skills: oral presentation, speech

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks:

- Term 1: Student-teacher interview
(ML4-CRT-01, ML4-INT-01)
- Term 2: Family tree and letter writing
(ML4-CRT-01)
- Term 3: Simultaneous interpreter
(ML4-UND-01)
- Term 4: Investigating the teacher's work schedule
(ML4-UND-01)
