

Year 7 Chinese - Assessment Plan - 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills in-class reading and comprehension of content from a wide variety of sources
- Writing skills: note-taking, identifying, and composing various text types e.g., script, letter, email.
- Speaking skills: oral presentation, speech
