



Year 9 Chinese – Assessment Plan – 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation – discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills - in-class reading and comprehension of content from a wide variety of sources
- Writing skills: note-taking, identifying and composing various text types eg: script, letter, email
- Speaking skills: oral presentation, speech

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks:
