

Year 9 Mathematics – Assessment Plan – 2024

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Answering and asking questions in class
- Explaining to the class or a classmate how to do something
- Completion of worksheets, classwork, homework and bookwork
- Summarising a topic
- Topic Tests
- Completion of major take-home assignments, with opportunity for advice on improvement
- Small quizzes, short formal testing (both open and closed book)
- Formal examination period
- Class presentations

Tasks used for assessment may include (but are not limited to):

- Financial Mathematics real-life application task
- Geometry investigation
- 'Pyramid' Measurement and Problem Solving task
- Probability, data-gathering and prediction assignment
- Topic Testing All units

All outcomes may be assessed
