1	1	<b>Unit 1: New Life in Jesus</b>
	2	Students will examine key events and aspects of Jesus' time and their impact on humanity.
	3	Particular attention will be paid to the ongoing significance of the death and resurrection of Jesus and in particular how the events of his life and resurrection can
	4	be applied to contemporary life.
	5	- Belonging to a group or family.
	6	- The family and friends of Jesus.
	7	- The key values of the Christian community and how these values are portrayed through celebration and sacrifice.
	8	- The local church as the heart of every Christian community.
	9	- The celebration of the Eucharist.
	10	Assessment Tasks - Mapping Jesus' journey and unit exam

2	1	<b>Unit 2: Jesus the teacher and healer</b>
	2	Students will examine Jesus as a teacher and healer. They will identify Jesus' teachings and His miracles as the basis for contemporary living, and particularly their own lives. Students
	3	will identify the mission of Jesus including the importance of miracles and parables in his
	4	work, and examine them to describe Jesus' attitude towards others.
	5	- The settings of Jesus' life and teachings.
	6	- Jesus as a teacher and guide for living a Christian life.
	7	- Parables as an important part of Jesus' teaching, and the link to the Kingdom of God.
	8	- Jesus, the healer as portrayed in the Gospels.
	9	Assessment Task - Oral Presentation (a modern day story with a message)
3	1	<b>Unit 3: The Ten Commandments &amp; the Beatitudes</b>
	2	Students will examine aspects of the Ten Commandments and The Beatitudes and identify
	3	how they can call us to access 'Faith, Trust, Generosity, Justice and Love.
	4	- The old testament and God's creativity
	5	- The Ten Commandments as a covenant, and their key values.
	6	- The importance of rules and their motivation for love.
	7	- The meaning of 'Beatitude'.
	8	- The underlying message of the Beatitudes.
	9	Assessment Task - Pairs research task and presentation on key values of the Beatitudes
	10	
4	1	<b>Unit 4: Christian Celebration</b>
	2	Students will examine the importance of Celebrations, especially within the Christian
	3	Tradition. Emphasis will be placed on the Christmas story and on Jesus, Mary and Joseph and
	4	the message for contemporary living.
	5	- The importance of celebration and celebration in the Church's tradition
	6	- The relationship between the Church's celebration and its mission.
	7	- The birth of Christ and Christianity.
	8	- Beliefs and practices of Christianity.
