Network and online resources Acceptable Use Policy

Welcome to the St Paul's International College network. Your network accounts give you access to workstations, printing facilities, Intranet and Internet services. Accounts are password protected and are set up by the IT department.

You also have access to an electronic mail (email) account that can be used to send and receive email. Access to the World Wide Web (WWW) and email is available through school workstations as through the wireless network. This access is provided for educational purposes.

Monitoring

The Catholic Education Office (CEO), Wollongong and/or the College reserves the right to monitor any and/or all local area network, Intranet and Internet related activity undertaken by staff and students at the College, including, but not exclusively.

- activity relating to its Internet and Intranet sites
- activity relating to Internet access
- e-mail

If required for legal purposes, e-mail content can be retrieved from archived media. In addition to SPAM and Virus scanning, e-mail is also scanned for words that would be considered offensive. Messages containing offensive language that are 'sent' by users are in fact captured by the system and forwarded to the local Administrator for action in accordance with Acceptable Use Policy.

All staff and students at the College should be aware that they are subject to monitoring of network use and make sure they are acting at all times within the Acceptable Use Policy of St Paul's International College and the CEO.

At St Paul's International College, you can use the Network to:

- Access shared files
- Store your own personal files (home directory, H:/ drive)
- Use resources such as networked computers, printers and scanners
- Access your email

St Paul's provides students with Network access (this includes the Internet) for:

- Researching school assignments
- Class work with a teacher
- Emailing family and friends.
- Access the Internet and Intranet

At St Paul's, the network CAN NOT be used for:

- Downloading games, game cheats or game patches
- Viewing web pages that have nothing to do with your school work
- Downloading music (MP3 or other format) or video clips not related to school work
- Viewing, downloading or uploading pornography
- Sending Emails containing offensive language.
- Gambling
- Playing online games
- Harassing or bullying other people
