



Year 11 EAL/D – Assessment Plan – 2026

Students will be continuously assessed in a variety of ways including:

- Homework tasks
- Class participation including discussion and presentations
- Group work
- Personal engagement in the texts and concepts studied
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills - in-class reading and analysis of content from a wide variety of texts
- Writing skills: summaries, paragraphing, note-taking, identifying and composing various text types eg: essays, speeches, imaginative pieces, visual representations, media texts

Schools are required to submit to NESAs a grade for each Year 11 student based on their achievement at the end of the course.

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks to determine that grade:
