



## Year 10 History Assessment Plan 2026

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation – discussions, Q&A
- Bookwork
- Revision tests and quizzes
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills : in-class reading and comprehension
- Writing skills : summaries, paragraphs, text types writing

Tasks used for assessment will include the following:

**Term 1** (Overview; The Industrial Revolution; Making a Nation)

- Research and Presentation (HT5-1, HT5-2, HT5-7, HT5-10)

**Term 2** (Australians at War)

- Skills task: ICT 'analysis and use of sources' (HT5-1, HT5-4, HT5-5)

**Term 3** (Treaty of Versailles, Rise of Totalitarianism, WWII)

- Essay Task (HT5-2, HT5-3, HT5-6, HT5-9, HT5-10)

**Term 4** (The Holocaust )

- News segment ( HT5-2, HT5-3, HT5-6, HT5-8, HT5-9, HT5-10)
