



Stage 4 Technology Mandatory – Assessment Plan – 2026

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation – discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement.
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Analysing Design Situations
- Research skills and using research in the decision making process.
- Skills in Recording and effectively communicating design ideas.
- Skills in developing solutions using a variety of materials.
- ICT skills in using a range of software including MS WORD, MS EXCEL, MS PowerPoint and Tinkercad.
- Safe and correct use of woodworking tools.
- Citing sources and incorporating bibliographies

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks:

- Term 1: Tinkercad designed and 3D printed Bag Tag and Folio.

- Term 2: Tinkercad designed and 3D printed Mobile Phone Holder (Group project) and Folio.

- Term 3: Simple Machines used By Indigenous people research task, Child's Toy Folio Sub 1

- Term 4: Child's Toy and Design Folio
(TE4-DES-01, TE4-PPM-01, TE4-SAF-01)
