Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation – discussions, Q&A
- Bookwork
- Revision tests and quizzes
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills: in-class reading and comprehension
- Writing skills: summaries, paragraphs, text types writing
