2	1	Unit: Commedia dell' arte (25 hours)
	2	Focus Outcomes: 5.1.1, 5.1.2, 5.1.4, 5.2.2, 5.2.3, 5.3.2, 5.3.3.
	3	In this unit students study the context and conventions of Commedia dell'Arte. This unit incorporates the use of mask, comedy and improvisation to explore character and scenarios. Students will create their own character mask, and perform a contemporary devised work using their mask.

3	1	Unit: Scripted Drama (25 hours)
	2	Focus Outcomes: 5.1.3, 5.1.4, 5.2.1., 5.2.3, 5.2.2, 5.3.1, 5.3.2, 5.3.3
	3	Unit- Scripted Drama- students learn how to interpret and perform scripted drama, using production elements to enhance their final performance. Students will also review a play.
